DEWORMING GUIDELINES

All horses do not need to be dewormed every 2 months. Current recommendations call for deworming to be based on risk and using fecal egg counts for monitoring parasite levels and dewormer effectiveness. This table is based on Kansas States recommendations and are examples of possible deworming strategies to use based on risk.

| Low | Iv-P | PPP | | | | Q-P |

| High | Mx-P | | PPP | Iv | Iv-P | Q-P |

Iv-P: Ivermectin + Praziquantel (Zimectrin Gold, Equimax)

Q-P: Moxidectin + Praziquantel (Quest Plus)

PPP: Fenbendazole double dose multi day (Panacur Power Pack)

Iv: Ivermectin (Zimectrin, Eqvalan)
